HEAD START:

Head Start is a federal program that promotes school readiness for children ages birth to five from low-income families. Ten percent of Head Start's enrollment must include children with special needs; ten percent may also be over the income guidelines.

- ▼ The Early Head Start Program provides home based and center-based services to pregnant women, infants, and toddlers. The program runs year-round.
- ▼ The Head Start Program serves families with children that are three to five years old. Services are either 9-month or year-round. Year-round classroom options are in Hutchinson, Willmar, Tracy, and Marshall. United Head Start offers a variety of program options for preschool-age children and their families.

OPTIONS, HOURS, AND LOCATIONS:

▼ EARLY HEAD START HOME BASED GROUPS:

The Home-Based option provides year-round services to the child and family in their own home. A staff person visits once a week for 1½ hours. Twice a month children and families attend a socialization.

▼ EARLY HEAD START TODDLER CENTER-BASED

The Toddler Classroom options are in Willmar, Marshall, Hutchinson & Tracy. It is a year-round classroom that serves 16-month to 3-year-olds. The classroom is Monday through Thursday, and some Fridays from 8:30am to 3:30pm.

▼ EARLY HEAD START INFANT CENTER-BASED

The Infant Classroom options are in Marshall and Willmar. It is year-round center-based care that serves children 6 weeks to 15 months. The schedule is Monday through Thursday, and some Fridays from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm.

Head Start partners with families to develop a plan to reach their goals. Parents can increase their skills through trainings, committees, volunteering, and employment. Head Start staff recognizes that parents are the first and most important teachers of their children. Staff welcome parent engagement in Head Start activities – staff and parents work together to help children progress.

RECRUITMENT / SELECTION / ENROLLMENT / ATTENDANCE:

- ▼ Families are encouraged to complete an application. <u>Applications are completed interview style.</u> When an application and family income is received, the documents will be reviewed and scored using the United Head Start Selection Criteria.
- Applicants with the highest needs are selected for the program first.
- ♥ When an applicant is enrolled in the program, it is important to attend on a regular basis eitherin the classroom or home visits

Other Recruitment efforts include news releases, radio/cable television announcements, posters, door-to-door, parent referrals, and networking with other community resources.
